- For individuals with mobility challenges needing safer bathroom access

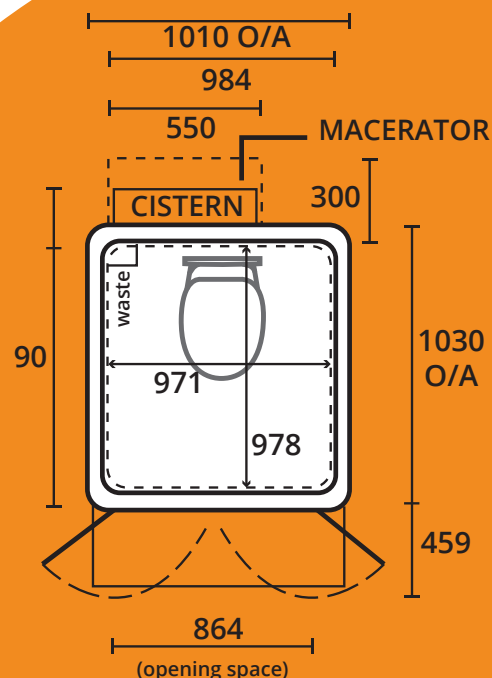
Technical Specifications & Requirements:

- Ramp size: 1000mm width x 430mm depth (standard model)
- Ramp size: 895mm width x 430mm depth (longer model)
- Allow 300mm at rear for plumbing services
- Allow as much space as possible for ease of user access
- 10 amp, 240-volt power point
- Access to a garden tap
- Access to a sewer gully trap
- Located close to an openable window or door

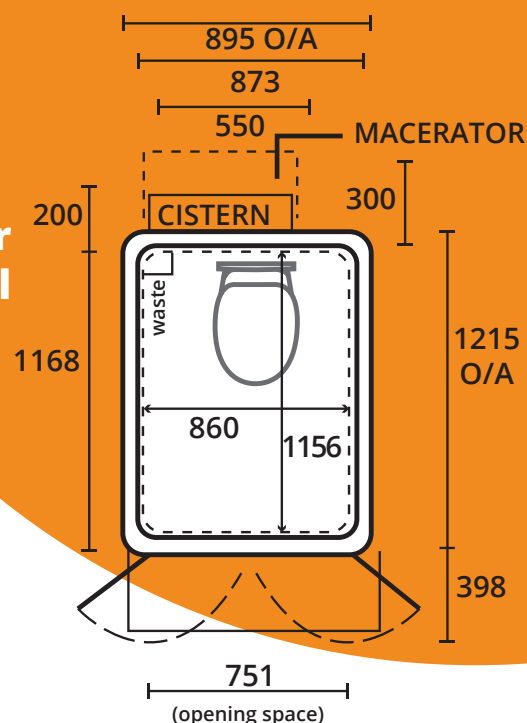
Who Benefits from the CarePort?
